General Guidelines

1. All Competitors should be below the age of 19 as at 1st of January 2017
2. Confirm your participation on or before 8th of February 2017
3. Students are requested to be present in their college dress code adhering to Sharia Rules and Regulations
4. Late registrations would not be much tolerated without a valid reason
5. One competitor could participate only at **ONE INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION** and at **A GROUP EVENT**
6. Competitions would be held under following age category,
 - **Junior** – Grade 6, 7 & 8 (Below 13 Years as at 1st of January 2017)
 - **Intermediate** – Grade 9, 10 & 11 (Below 17 Years as at 1st of January 2017)
 - **Senior** – Grade 12 & 13 (Below 19 Years as at 1st of January 2017)
7. Competitions would be held in English, Sinhala and Tamil Languages (Mediums)
8. Use of electronic media or false play during the competitions would not be tolerated & would be penalised
9. Any issues or problems faced during the competitions should be brought forward by the relevant Teacher in Charge of the respective school and should be produced in a written form to the help desk during the competition, late complains would not be entertained without a valid reason
10. Entry forms should be signed by the respected authorities & should be produced at the registration desks on the day of the competition
11. Judge's decision would be the final
12. Participation marks would be allocated
13. Students' who are not participating at any events would not be permitted to enter the College premises, except for 2 Board Members and a Teacher in Charge
14. Groups that have suspicious acts would be Disqualified

Qurath Competition Guidelines

- Girls and boys would be judged separately
- Only 1 member could participate per category
- A Quran will be provided at the day of the competition, therefore please **refrain** from bringing the Quran to the competition hall

Qaseeda Competition Guidelines

- This is an open event
- A team should consist of 4 members
- Girls and boys would be judged separately
- A time limit of 4 – 6 mins would be given to each team
- Qaseeda / Islamic Song of any language is permitted (English, Urdu, Arabic, Etc.)

Quiz Competition Guidelines

- This is an open event conducted in all 3 languages
- Segregated seating for males and females
- Questions would be raised in regarding Islamic Shariah, Islamic History, the Quran, Hadees, general knowledge and current affairs
- 1st & 2nd rounds would be in written form whereas the semi-finals and final would be quizzed orally
- Answer sheets from outside would not be permitted into the quiz hall
- A team should consist of 4 members

Calligraphy Competition Guidelines

- This is an open event
- Use of black colour drawing instruments are only permissible
- Only bristle boards would be provided at the day of the competitions
- The Quranic phrase would be provided at the day of the competitions
- Each competitor would be provided with 2 hours of duration
- A team should consist of 2 members

Essay Competition Guidelines

- Writing Sheets only would be provided
- Sheets from outside would not allowed
- Each competitor would be provided with 2 hours of duration
- Only 1 member could participate per age category representing his / her respective medium

Speech Competition Guidelines

- Bringing of any sheets inside the competition hall is not tolerable
- Only 1 member could participate per age category representing His/her respective medium
- Time limits for each category are as follows;
 - ❖ *Junior – 4 to 5 minutes*
 - ❖ *Intermediate – 5 to 6 minutes*
 - ❖ *Senior – 6 to 7 minutes*

Multimedia Presentation Competition Guidelines

- This is an open event
- Only 2 members could participate in this competition
- Using music would be disqualified
- The presentation should be within 7 minutes
- This competition will be hosted in English only

Debating Competitions Guidelines

- Each Debating team should comprise of 3 candidates only
- Each team member shall speak for 3 minutes whereas, the captain shall receive 4 minutes in his final speech
- Every competitor should be aged with effect from 1998-2-13
- Kindly note that, the Debating event for the 56th Islam day will be hosted in Sinhalese only
