Rules and Regulations



General Guidelines

1. All Competitors should be below the age of 19 as at 1st of January 2017
2. Confirm your participation on or before 2nd of February 2017
3. Students are requested to be present in their college dress code and be on time
4. One competitor could participate only at **TWO INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION** and at **ANY GROUP EVENT**
5. Competitions would be held under following age category,
 - **Junior** – Grade 6, 7 & 8 (Below 13 Years as at 1st of January 2017)
 - **Intermediate** – Grade 9, 10 & 11 (Below 17 Years as at 1st of January 2017)
 - **Senior** – Grade 12 & 13 (Below 19 Years as at 1st of January 2017)
6. Competitions would be held in English, Sinhala and Tamil Languages (Mediums)
7. Use of electronic media or false play during the competitions would not be tolerated & would be penalised
8. Any issues or problems faced during the competitions should be brought forward by the relevant Teacher in Charge or the House Captain of the respective house and should be produced in a written form to the help desk during the competition, late complains would not be entertained without a valid reason.
9. Entry forms should be signed by the respected authorities & should be produced at the registration desks on the day of the competition
10. Judge's decision would be the final
11. Participation marks would be allocated
12. We would highly appreciate the participants to abide by the rules and regulations and maintain orderliness to make this event a great success

Quirath Competition Guidelines

- Only 3 members could participate per house from all 3 age categories
- A Quran would be provided at the day of competition

Qaseeda Competition Guidelines

- Only 4 members could participate per team from all 3 age categories
- A time limit of 4 – 6 mins would be given to each team

Quiz Competition Guidelines

- Groups that have suspicious acts would be Disqualified
- Would be conducted in all 3 languages
- Questions will be raised in regarding Islamic Shariah, Islamic History, the Quran, Hadees, general knowledge and current affairs
- Answer sheets from outside will not be allowed into the quiz hall
- A team must consist of 4 members

Calligraphy Competition Guidelines

- Only black colour must be used for the event
- Only bristle boards would be provided at the day of the competitions
- The Quranic phrase would be provided at the day of the competitions
- Each competitor would be provided with 2 hours of duration
- Only 3 members could participate per age category representing a house

Essay Competition Guidelines

- Writing Sheets only would be provided
- Sheets from outside would not allowed
- Each competitor would be provided with 2 hours of duration
- Only 3 members could participate per age category and per medium representing a house

Speech Competition Guidelines

- Bringing of any sheets inside the competition hall is not allowed
- Only 3 members could participate per age category and per medium representing a house

- Time limits for each category are as follows;
 - ❖ *Junior – 4 to 5 minutes*
 - ❖ *Intermediate – 5 to 6 minutes*
 - ❖ *Senior – 6 to 7 minutes*

Multimedia Presentation Competition Guidelines

- Only 2 members could participate representing a house from the Senior Age Category (Grade 12 & 13 only)
- This competition could only be done in English Language
- Using music would be disqualified
- The presentation should be within 7 minutes

Card Designing Competition Guidelines

- Only 2 members could participate per Junior & Intermediate Age Category representing a house (Grade 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 & 12 only)
- Can use any Editing Software
- The Card could be designed graphically and handmade
- The card should be submitted via email to islamicsociety@zahiracollege.lk or handed over to any board officials on or before the 2nd of February 2017
- The theme could be selected at the participants free-will and should be related according to the Islamic Culture

Drama Competition Guidelines

- A maximum of 10 members could participate from the Senior Age Category representing a house
- Any language could be used
- The drama should be around 10 - 15 minutes
- The Drama theme should be based on Islamic Etiquettes
- Points would be deducted if the count of the members increase or decrease
